The Avery Bracelet uses the Czech Glass 2-Hole Silky Beads and with their diamond shape you can make a fun argyle-like pattern just by using various colors.

**Instructions**

These instructions will give you a bracelet that is approximately 6 inches. To adjust the length, add or subtract the number of beads.

1. To begin, cut four lengths of beading wire 10 inches each.
2. Take all four stands and space them out in a bead stopper. Lay them out in front of you. And count from the top down: 1, 2, 3, 4.
3. To wire 1, string: 1 seed bead, 1 round bead, 1 seed bead, and 1 grey silky bead.
4. To wire 2, string: 1 seed bead, 1 white silky bead, and 1 seed bead. Then string thru the grey silky bead that is on wire 1.
5. To wire 3, string: 1 seed bead, then string thru the white silky bead that is on wire 2. And string one more seed bead.
6. To wire 4, string: 1 seed bead, 1 round bead, 1 seed bead, and the bottom hole of 1 yellow silky bead. Now take wire 3 and string it thru the top hole of this yellow bead.
7. You will repeat this process until you have 12 grey, 13 white, and 12 yellow silky beads. If you would like a longer bracelet just keep going with the pattern. Make sure that you end the beading the same way you started, with the seed beads.
8. On one end, string one crimp tube onto one wire. Thread it through one closed jump ring and back through the crimp tube. Pull snug and crimp the crimp tube.
9. Repeat the above process so that on each side you have wires 1 and 2 on the same jump ring and wires 3 and 4 on a second jump ring.
10. To each closed jump ring you will attach one open jump ring and one end of the corresponding magnetic clasp. Close the jump rings.
11. All done!
