

Pink Sugar Bracelet

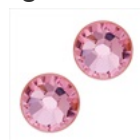

SWAROVSKI ELEMENTS Crystal Flatback Rhinestones 2058 Enhanced SS40 Light Rose (8)

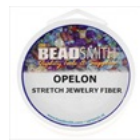

Instructions:

Please note that you will also need a measuring cup and stir sticks for this project.

1. You can see how to make this bracelet in the video: [How to Use Pearlizing Powder in Resin](#).
2. After you have poured the resin, let it fully cure, and restrung the bracelet, then proceed to the next step.
3. Use a toothpick or small piece of wire as an applicator and apply a dab of E6000 glue to the center of one of your bracelet bezels. Into this glue place a SWAROVSKI ELEMENTS flat back rhinestone in light rose. Let fully dry in an upright position.
4. Repeat the last step with your 7 remaining rhinestones, letting each one dry before proceeding onto the next bezel/rhinestone.
5. Enjoy!

Variations

Try making this same bracelet with a different color of flat back rhinestone.

When substituting in items, pay attention to sizes and styles to make sure all your pieces will fit together.
