Instructions

You will also need toothpicks for this project.

- 1. To see an example of a similar project, please watch our video: How to Make a Pair of Resin Earrings featuring Nunn Design Earring Bezels. In this video you will learn how to mix and colorize your resin to make a pair of earrings. You will also see some helpful tips for keeping your earrings level as they cure.
- 2. From what you learned in the video, set up your earrings on a box or something to keep them level. Mix your resin and separate it into two cups; one for green and one for red. Slowly add a drop or two of red to one, and a drop or two of green to the other. If you want a lighter color, you can add a little bit of white.
- 3. Once you have achieved your color, use a toothpick add the green to the leaf shapes and add the red to the round berry shapes.
- 4. Allow to cure at least 24 hours.
