

Atacama Earrings

Mixed metals and etched Czech glass combine on a loop of fine snake chain to create an earthy, delicate effect. A crimp cord end attaches the chain to the earring hook for a clean, secure finish.

What You'll Need

Czech Glass Beads, Teardrop 6x4mm, 25 Pieces, Etched Crystal Sliperit

True2 Czech Fire Polished Glass Beads, Faceted Round 2mm, 200 Pieces, Etched Crystal Full Chrome

Cutter Pliers - For Cutting Beading Wire, 1 Piece







Instructions

By following the instructions below, you will make one earring. Repeat all instructions to make the second earring.

- 1. Begin by using flush cutters to cut 3.25 inches of snake chain.
- 2. Onto your chain, string on the following beads: 5 silver, 1 drop, 2 silver, 1 drop, 5 silver.
- 3. Slide both ends of your chain into a crimp cord end bead, and crimp the bead.
- 4. Use pliers to gently open the loop at the base of your earring hook. Slide on the loop of the crimp cord end from the previous step, then close the loop of your earring hook. All done!
