## Instructions

1. Before you begin, watch the instructional video: How to Make a Quick and Easy Stacked Pandora Style Bead Necklace.
2. Cut an 18 " length of 22 k gold plated figaro chain.
3. Hang a 22 k gold plated pewter Indian elephant charm from your chain using a gold plated 7 mm , 18 gauge jump ring.
4. Then bring both ends of your chain together and string them through a gold plated black enamel large hole bead, a hand blown clear glass large hole bead, and another black large hole bead.
5. Use a gold plated 4 mm , 21 gauge jump ring to attach a gold plated lobster clasp to one end of your chain. Attach a second 4 mm jump ring to the other end of your chain.
