Elegant and sophisticated, this kumihimo necklace is actually braided with chain. Although the finished result looks complicated, the design is simple to create.

### What You'll Need

22K Gold Plated Slim Rolo Chain 2mm Bulk By The Foot

Silver Plated Bulk Chain, Round Rolo 2mm, Sold By The Foot

Artistic Wire, Silver Plated Craft Wire 24 Gauge Thick, 10 Yard Spool, Gold Color

SKU: WCR-4598 Project uses 24 inches

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22K Gold Plated Sleek Lobster Claw Clasps 9mm (10)

#### Instructions

There is no real difference to the Kumhimo braiding technique whether using chain or cord. The real difference is how you start and finish the braid.

- 1. To see how to make this necklace from start to finish, please watch the video: How to Make a Kumihimo Chain Necklace.
- 2. In the course of the video you will learn how to cut your chains to the appropriate lengths, tie their ends together with wire, create a simple 8-warp kumihimo braid, end your braids with wire, create wrapped wire loops, and finally how to finish off your design with lengths of single chains and a clasp.
