

## Mod Circles Bracelet

Project B1020

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Make this mod-inspired bracelet in a jiffy using fast and easy Quick Links. The two tone metal rings and hardware will match anything!

NOTE: The clasp used in this project has been discontinued and a slightly smaller clasp has replaced it. The overall look of the bracelet will not change much, but the size of the clasp is a bit smaller.



### What You'll Need

Beadalon Silver Plated Quick Links 20mm Round (22 Pcs)

Beadalon Gold Plated Quick Links 25mm Round (18 Pcs)

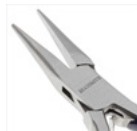

### Specialized Tools

Beadsmith Jeweller's Micro Pliers Chain Nose Flat Nose

### Instructions:

These instructions will make a bracelet that measures about 7.5". If you would like to lengthen or shorten your bracelet, add or subtract sets of links. Each stacked link adds about an inch.

1. Begin by watching the video: How to Use Beadalon Quick Links and Connectors.
2. Use two small silver plated Quick Links connectors to secure a 20mm silver plated round Quick Link inside a 25mm gold plated round Quick Link. See photo for placement details. The silver Quick Link will rest to one side of the gold Quick Link.
3. Repeat the last step to make five more stacked links.
4. Attach a large silver plated Quick Links connector to one side of a stacked link, making sure to enclose both rings in one side of the connector. Attach the other side of the large connector to another stacked link in the same manner. See photo for placement details.
5. Repeat the last step two more times, so that you end up with three sets of two stacked links.
6. Use small connectors on the other side of the stacked links (enclosing just the larger rings) to attach your three groups of links into a continuous chain. See photo for placement details.
7. Use small connectors to attach one side of a large silver plated toggle clasp to each end of your bracelet.

### Variations

Play around with the different finishes, shapes, and sizes of Quick Links to change the look of this bracelet.

When substituting in items, pay attention to sizes and styles to make sure all your pieces will fit together.
