Create this lovely bangle bracelet by covering a wide Nunn Design Channel Bangle with a strip of peyote stitched Miyuki

Delica beads in a pretty black and gray tone mix.

Instructions

- 1. Before you begin, watch the instructional video: How to Cover a Channel Bangle with Bead Weaving.
- 2. Using a size 12 beading needle and .006" smoke grey Fireline, weave a strip of even count flat peyote 18 beads wide with size 11/0 tuxedo mix of Delica beads.
- 3. As demonstrated in the video, continue to weave until your piece is just short of reaching all the way around the channel of your bangle.
- 4. End your row so that your first and last row match up and fit together, with just about 1/8" or slightly less of a gap.
- $\hbox{5. Zip your ends together as demonstrated in the video}. \ \hbox{Tie off and weave in your threads}.$
