What You'll Need

Czech Glass Beads 9mm Bell Beadcaps Red Ruby (10)





Instructions:

- 1. Onto fourteen headpins thread the following: a 4mm round gold bead, a glass bell (seven green, seven red), and a bead cap.
- 2. Create a simple loop on each headpin and trim off excess wire.
- 3. Onto thirteen more headpins thread a single 4mm round gold bead.
- 4. Create a simple loop on each of these and trim off excess wire.
- 5. Cut a piece of chain about seven inches long (you may make it longer or shorter depending on how you would like your bracelet to fit).
- 6. Open one 7mm jump ring and one 3mm jump ring.
- 7. Thread the 7mm jump ring through the last link at one end of your chain and close the jump ring once more.
- 8. Thread the 3mm jump ring through the last link at the other end of the chain and through the loop on your lobster clasp. Close the jump ring.
- 9. Open the loops on each of the headpin dangles and add them to your chain, alternating red and green bells with a gold round bead dangle in between each. Close all loops.
