Instructions

These instructions will give you a bracelet that is 7 inches. To adjust the length, adjust the pattern accordingly. Before beginning this project please watch the video: How to do Peyote Bead Weaving with Various Sizes of Beads.

- 1. Cut off a length of beading thread. Use a length that you are comfortable working with. As you work you will have to tie off and weave in new thread.
- 2. Follow along with the pattern, starting with the top right. The colors correspond with the various sizes of beads for this design.
- 3. To attach the clasp, please watch the video: How to Attach Tube Clasps to Peyote Bead Weaving.
- 4. Tie off and weave in all threads.
