

# **Avery Bracelet**

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The Avery Bracelet uses the Czech Glass 2-Hole Silky Beads and with their diamond shape you can make a fun argyle-like pattern just by using various colors.

#### **Recommended Tools:**

[XTL-3000] Bead Stopper- Stop Beads Sliding Off Stringing Material, [XTL-5600] Sharp Flush Cutter Pliers - For Cutting Beading Wire, 1 Piece, [XTL-5200] Standard Size Beading Crimping Pliers (For 2x2mm & 2x1mm Crimp Beads), [XTL-5514] Beadsmith Jewellry Fine Round Nose Micro Pliers, [XTL-5511] Beadsmith Jeweller's Micro Pliers Chain Nose Flat Nose

#### Instructions

These instructions will give you a bracelet that is approximately 6 inches. To adjust the length, add or subtract the number of beads.

- 1. To begin, cut four lengths of beading wire 10 inches each.
- 2. Take all four stands and space them out in a bead stopper. Lay them our in front of you. And count from the top down: 1, 2, 3, 4.
- 3. To wire 1, string: 1 seed bead, 1 round bead, 1 seed bead, and 1 grey silky bead.
- 4. To wire 2, string: 1 seed bead, 1 white silky bead, and 1 seed bead. Then string thru the grey silky bead that is on wire 1.
- 5. To wire 3, string: 1 seed bead, then string thru the white silky bead that is on wire 2. And string one more seed bead.
- 6. To wire 4, string: 1 seed bead, 1 round bead, 1 seed bead, and the bottom hole of 1 yellow silky bead. Now take wire 3 and string it thru the top hole of this yellow bead.
- 7. You will repeat this process until you have 12 grey, 13 white, and 12 yellow silky beads. If you would like a longer bracelet just keep going with the pattern. Make sure that you end the beading the same way you started, with the seed beads.
- 8. On one end, string one crimp tube onto one wire. Thread it through one closed jump ring and back through the crimp tube. Pull snug and crimp the crimp tube.
- 9. Repeat the above process so that on each side you have wires 1 and 2 on the same jump ring and wires 3 and 4 on a second jump ring.
- 10. To each closed jump ring you will attach one open jump ring and one end of the corresponding magnetic clasp. Close the jump rings.
- 11. All done!
