## Instructions

These instructions will give you a bracelet that is 6.25 " inches. To modify the length, adjust the number of knotted beads and chain accordingly.

1. Take the griffin silk off the card and stretch it. If you have not done pearl knotting before, please watch our video, How to Pearl Knotting Using Tweezers.
2. Leave a tail of about 4 inches on the end without the needle. Tie a knot around one 8 mm jump ring. Double knot this so that the tail is securely sound this jump ring.
3. Place a small dab of GS Hypo Cement on to the knot and cover with a crimp cover. Trim the tail.
4. Using the pearl knotting technique, knot 30 gemstone beads.
5. Place one more gemstone bead onto this strand. String on the loop if the hook clasp. Tie a knot around the loop of the clasp. Double knot it and place a small dab of GS Hypo Cement on to the knot and cover with a crimp cover.
6. On the tail make another double knot, place a small dab of GS Hypo Cement on to the knot and cover with a crimp cover.
7. Knot 30 gemstone beads.
8. Place one more gemstone bead onto this strand. Tie a knot around the closed jump ring. Double knot it and place a small dab of GS Hypo Cement on to the knot and cover with a crimp cover. Trim the tail of the silk.
9. Cut two pieces of 8 inches of chain. Note: You may need more or less depending on how twisted you would like the chain.
10. Open one jump ring, attach two ends of the chain to the jump ring and attach this jump ring to the closed jump ring.
11. Twist or braid these two chains through the two strands of knotted gemstones.
12. Come to the side of the bracelet with the clasp and open another jump ring. Attach the two ends of the chain to the loop of the clasp. Close the jump ring.
13. All done!
