## Instructions

These instructions will give you a bracelet that is 6.75 ". To adjust the size, simply vary the number of beads used accordingly.

1. Cut off 12 inches of beading wire.
2. Place a bead stopper about two inches from one end.
3. String on the beads in this order: one 6 mm gold spacer bead, one 6 mm jasper bead, one 6 mm gold spacer bead, one 6 mm jasper bead, one 6 mm gold spacer bead, three 6 mm jasper beads, one 6 mm gold spacer bead, three 6 mm jasper beads, one 8 mm gold spacer bead, one 8 mm jasper bead, one 8 mm gold spacer bead, two 8 mm jasper bead, and one Buddha bead. Now reverse the order to complete the other side of the bracelet.
4. Once all your beads have been strung, string on one crimp tube and one end of the magnetic clasp. Take the wire and go back down through the crimp tube. Crimp the crimp tube. Snip off the excess wire and add a crimp cover.
5. Move to the other side of the bracelet, remove the bead stopper. Repeat the previous step to finish this side of the bracelet.
6. All done!
