Instructions

These instructions will give you a 7 inch bracelet. To adjust the length simply add or subtract the number of beads respectively.

1. Take one eye pin and string on one 10 mm pearl. Make a simple wire loop. Set aside. Repeat for two more 10 mm pearls, six 8 mm pearls, and four 6 mm pearls.
2. Next, you will open and close the simple wire loops, same as you would jump rings, and link them together in the following order: 6 mm pearl, 8 mm pearl, 10 mm pearl, 8 mm pearl, 6 mm pearl, 8 mm pearl, 10 mm pearl, 8 mm pearl, 6 mm pearl, 8 mm pearl, 10 mm pearl, 8 mm pearl, 6 mm pearl.
3. Finally attach one end of the magnetic clasp the 6 mm pearls on each end.
