## Instructions

This bracelet measures $6.5^{\prime \prime}$ inches, to modify the length, simply adjust the number of beads strung.

1. Begin by cutting off 12 inches of beading wire and placing a Bead Stopper two inches from one end.
2. Then string on the beads in the following order: 6 mm olivine, 6 mm light colorado topaz, 6 mm olivine, 4 mm topaz. Then repeat this pattern 5 times and end with 6 mm olivine, 6 mm light colorado topaz and 6 mm olivine.
3. String on one crimp tube. String the wire through one loop of the magnetic clasp and back down through the crimp tube. Crimp the crimp tube. Then add a crimp cover and trim the wire.
4. Move to the other side of the bracelet and repeat the above step.
