What You'll Need

Miyuki Round Seed Beads, 11/0, 8.5 Gram Tube, #1053 Galvanized Yellow Gold

Instructions

This bracelet measures approximately 6.5 inches. To modify the length, simply adjust the length woven respectively.

1. To see a similar design, please watch our video: How to do a Modified Right Angle Weave with Two Hole Beads. From what you learned in this video, begin the weaving with the superduo beads and pearls. To follow along with the pattern in the photo, you will need to alternate the green and blue pearls so that the blue pearls are in the center of the bracelet and the green pearls are on the outside edges. Another change to the video is that instead of building it sideways so that it is double wide, simply continue in one long strand.

2. Once you have achieved your desired length, please watch our video: How to Finish Right Angle Weave with Cymbal Bead Endings. In this video you will learn how to finish the bracelet with Cymbal Bead Endings and how to attach the magnetic clasp.
