Regaliz Portuguese Cork Cord, Round and Braided 6mm, By The Inch, Pale Turquoise





## Instructions

This bangle bracelet measures 8 inches, 7" for the cork cord and 1" for the focal. To make a bracelet that is longer or shorter, simply adjust the length of cork cord.



2. Repeat with the other end of your cork cord length and glue into your second barrel cord end.







- 3. Next, take your 2" silver plated eye pin and string on 6 pieces of sea glass beads (I looked through my selection of sea glass and chose the pieces that looked the best together, size and shape-wise). Once all the beads are on, create a simple wire loop and snip off any excess wire using your flush cutters.
- 4. Using your chain nose pliers, open a silver plated jump ring and slide it onto the loop of one of your cord ends. Before closing, also slide it onto the simple loop on one end of your eye pin. Close the jump ring.
- 5. Repeat with the second cord end and second simple loop on your eye pin.
- 6. All done!
