## Instructions

This memory wire bracelet has 5 loops. To make it wider or narrower, simply adjust the number of loops and beads.

1. Begin by cutting a 5 loop length of your gold memory wire using your memory wire cutters.
2. Using your round nose pliers, create a simple wire loop onto one end of your memory wire.
3. Thread on 129 Pukalet wood beads. Once all the beads are on, create another simple wire loop.
4. Next, watch the video on How to Make Tassels for Jewelry
5. Following what you learned in the video, cut your length of navy blue pearl cotton cord and create your tassel. Attach it onto a closed 7 mm gold plated jump ring.
6. Using your chain nose pliers, open a 5 mm jump ring and slide it onto one of the simple loops on your bracelet.
7. Onto that jump ring, slide on the jump ring with your tassel on it and also a second jump ring with your ohm charm. Close the jump ring. See photo.
8. You're done!
