What You'll Need

Solid Brass Flat Cuff Bracelet Base 50.8mm (2 Inches) Wide (1 Piece)

Lillypilly Copper Sheet Metal Rectangle Mottled Patina 36 Gauge - 3x6 Inch

E6000 Industrial Strength Glue Adhesive (0.18 fl oz)

Instructions

Note: you will also need a ruler, pen, and several rubber bands or hair bands for this project.

- 1. To start this project, please watch the video: How to Cover a Brass Cuff in Lillypilly Copper Sheets.
- 2. From what you learned in the video, measure and cut your Lillypilly rectangle so that it is 1 5/8" wide.
- 3. Now adhere your copper sheet to your brass cuff using E6000 glue as shown in the video.
- 4. Place the bands over the cuff to hold the copper sheet in place. Let dry.
- $5. \ \mbox{Remove}$ the bands and trim your copper ends as need be as shown in the video.
- 6. All done!
