## Instructions

NOTE: If you purchase just 1 more foot of each of the 3 SilverSilks lengths and 1 more pair of pinch end caps (FCR-7032) then you can make a matching necklace. The necklace is project N702 and can be found here.

3. If you plan on making the necklace too, then start by making the necklace and use your leftover SilverSilk to make the bracelet - do not pre-cut any of your lengths.
