This pretty bead woven bracelet features lovely lily petal beads along the outer edge with 2-hole Dobble beads and semi-glazed Toho beads in the center. The double needle method is used to create the design - a fun variation for those who love to bead weave.

Antiqued Brass Open Jump Rings 5mm 20 Gauge (x100)

Instructions

Note: this bracelet is a lot of fun to make but it is a bit more advanced with the 2-hole beads and the double needle method. It is not necessarily difficult, it just requires close attention to detail. Have fun!

- 1. To make this bracelet, please watch the video: How to Bead Weave a Bracelet using 2 Hole Dobble Beads and Lily Petal Beads.
- 2. In the video you will learn how to bead weave the bracelet from start to finish, how to attach the clasp, how to create a chain of jump rings (which makes the bracelet adjustable), and how to create the little decorative bead woven segment at the end of the chain of jump rings.
