This pretty on-trend bracelet is elegant in its simplicity. Wear the chain tails long or cut them short, either way the bracelet is sure to be a worn-often addition to your accessory wardrobe.

What You'll Need

Brass Bulk Chain, Tiny Rectangle Soldered Cable Links 1mm, By The Foot, Antiqued Brass

Adjustable Slider Clasp, Round with Silicone Center 8mm, 4 Pieces, Antiqued Brass Tone

SKU: BMB-023

Project uses 1 piece



Antiqued Brass 2mm Ball Head Pins - 21 Gauge Thick 2 Inches Long (20)

SKU: FHP-3033

Project uses 2 pieces



Antiqued Brass Balloon 4mm Round Beads (100)

Instructions

Please note you will need some thread for this project. Just a foot or so and it can be Wildfire, Nymo, Fireline, or any other type of thread.
