

# Candy Cane Lane Bracelet

A sweet pattern of alternating candy canes decorates this sparkly loom bracelet using a silver lined holiday palette of Miyuki round seed beads. The picot edging adds a frosty finish, with a slider clasp and extension chain for adjustable sizing.

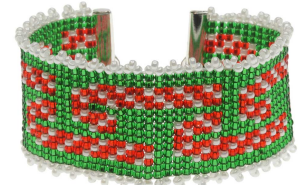

## Instructions

This bracelet has an extension clasp for adjustable length of 6.5 to 8.5 inches.

1. If you are new to loom weaving, begin by watching the video: How to Use the Jewel Loom Beading Loom. You will use size D Nymo to set up your loom as shown in the video. For this pattern you will need 16 warp threads.
2. Once your loom is set up, thread your loom needle with a length of Nymo as long as you are comfortable working with. You will need to tie off and add new thread to your loom weaving as you work.
3. Follow the pattern shown in the illustration to create 5.75 inches of loom weaving, or continue the pattern to your desired length.
4. To create the picot beaded edge, please watch the video: How to Add a Beaded Edge to Loom Work. Using what you have learned in the video, work your way back up along the sides of your loom weaving to add the white picot edge, 3 beads per stitch (see photo for reference).
5. To finish off your bracelet, please watch the video: How to Finish Off Traditional Loom Work and Add a Slider Clasp. Follow along with the video to tie off the threads of your bracelet and attach the adjustable slider clasp. Enjoy!
