

Saratoga Bracelet in Frost

Icy blue and purple tones blend in this double strand bracelet featuring Czech glass 2-hole Ginko beads. The design incorporates brick beads and fire polish beads, with 11/0 and 8/0 Toho demi round seed beads adding a lustrous accent. An heirloom 2 loop toggle clasp by TierraCast completes the bracelet.

Czech Glass, 2-Hole Ginko Beads 7.5mm, 10 Grams, Polychrome Blueberry

[XTL-5600] Sharp Flush Cutter Pliers - For Cutting Beading Wire, 1 Piece, [XTL-0020] Baby Wubbers Quality Fine Chain Nose Jeweller's Pliers, [XTL-5200] Standard Size Beading Crimping Pliers (For 2x2mm & 2x1mm Crimp Beads)

Instructions

These instructions will make a 6.5 inch bracelet. For a longer or shorter bracelet, adjust the number of beads strung accordingly. Please watch our video on using demi rounds as spacers with Ginko beads. This video includes helpful tips for how to incorporate Toho 8/0 and 11/0 demi round seed beads into this bracelet design.

1. Begin by using flush cutters to cut two 12 inch lengths of beading wire. Onto one end of both strands, attach a bead stopper.

2. Onto one strand, string on one 8/0 demi round, one 11/0 demi round, one blue Ginko bead through the wide end, one 11/0 demi round, one 8/0 demi round, and one fire polish bead. Repeat this step in reverse to mirror the pattern. Then string on one brick bead.

3. Repeat the above step, this time stringing on purple Ginko beads.

4. Continue the pattern described in steps two and three for a total of 12 Ginko beads.

5. Repeat steps 2 through 4 on your second strand of beading wire by stringing on demi rounds in the order described above, and sending the wire through the second hole of each 2-hole bead as your pattern indicates.

6. Once all your beads are strung, add a crimp tube onto the end of one strand. Thread the wire through a loop on one side of your toggle clasp and back through the crimp tube. Pull snug and crimp the crimp tube. Clip the excess wire and add a crimp cover. Repeat this step to attach your second strand to the other loop on your toggle.

7. Remove the bead stopper and repeat the previous step to attach both loops of your toggle clasp on the opposite end of your bracelet. Enjoy!
