

Windsor Scalloped Bracelet in Iridescent Purple

Three graceful scallops made of Swarovski crystal pearls and TierraCast gold plated spacer beads are the focal of this design. Finishing the design is a pretty magnetic clasp that looks like a bead.

[XTL-5600] Sharp Flush Cutter Pliers - For Cutting Beading Wire, 1 Piece, [XTL-5608] Xuron 4 In 1 Crimping Pliers - Works On 1, 2 And 3mm Crimps!, [XTL-5450] Xuron Jeweler's Super Fine Pliers Chain Nose Flat Nose, [XTL-3000] Bead Stopper- Stop Beads Sliding Off Stringing



Material

Instructions

Please note that some crimp beads act as just pretty gold beads in this project. Do not crimp any of the strung crimp beads unless directed to do so.

1. Begin this project by cutting 2 lengths of beading wire that are 15 inches long each. Line up their ends and place a single bead stopper on both of them, 4 inches from the ends.
2. Onto each of the wires, string on 1 crimp bead, 1 4mm pearl, 1 spacer bead, 1 6mm pearl. Next take a 8mm bead double strand spacer bar and thread each one of the wires through each of the holes (1 wire per hole).
3. String onto each of the wires 1 6mm pearl, 1 spacer bead, 1 8mm pearl, 1 spacer bead, 1 6mm pearl. Next take a 8mm bead double strand spacer bar and thread each one of the wires through each of the holes (1 wire per hole).
4. String on 1 6mm pearl, 1 spacer bead, 1 4mm pearl, 1 crimp bead.
5. Bring both wires together at this point and feed them both through 1 spacer bead, 1 4mm pearl, 1 spacer bead. You have completed 1 full scallop.
6. Repeat steps 2 - 4 to make a second scallop.
7. Repeat steps 2 - 4 again to make your third scallop but leave off the very last spacer bead of step 4.
8. Thread both wires through a crimp bead. Separate out your clasp. Take both your wires and feed them through the loop on one half of the clasp and then go back through the crimp bead. Pull so that you have just a little bit of wiggle room for the clasp. Crimp your crimp bead using the very back notch of the Xuron 4-in-1 crimping pliers. Trim excess wire and place a crimp bead cover over the crimp bead.
9. Go back to your starting point and remove the bead stopper from this end. Feed both wires through 1 spacer bead, 1 4mm pearl, and 1 crimp bead. Take both your wires and feed them through the loop on one half of the clasp and then go back through the crimp bead. Pull so that you have just a little bit of wiggle room for the clasp. Crimp your crimp bead using the very back notch of the Xuron 4-in-1 crimping pliers. Trim excess wire and place a crimp bead cover over the crimp bead.
