## What You'll Need

- 6" (1 package) - Artistic Craft Wire Silver Plated Non Tarnish 20 Gauge 6 Yards (WCR-2030)
- 1 (1 package) - Beadalon Silver Plated Ball Head Pins - 22 Gauge - 2 Inches (24) (FHP-5319)
- 2 (1 package) - Bright Silver Plated Cone Flower Bead Caps $6 m m \times 3.5 m m$ (BMB-6459)
- 2 (1 package) - Bright Silver Plated Open Pinwheel Bead Caps 9mm (BMB-6462)
- 2 (1 package) - Bright Silver Plated Open Petal Flower Bead Caps 8mm (BMB-6456)
- 1 (1 package) - Bright Silver Plated Scalloped Flower Bead Caps 8 mm (BMB-6470)
- 1 (1 package) - Hand Blown Lampwork Glass 30mm Large Drop Beads White Silver Foil (BGL-1984)
- 1 (1 package) - Hand Blown Lampwork Glass 20mm Round Beads Green Silver Foil (BGL-1061)
- 1 (1 package) - Hand Blown Lampwork Glass 28mm Huge Round Beads Red Green Silver Foil (BGL-1943)
- 1 (1 package) - Swarovski Crystal \#5301 6mm Bicone Beads Light Siam (SWC-1685)


## Instructions:

1. Cut three pieces of wire at two inches long each.
2. Make a simple loop at one end of each piece of wire to make them into eyepins.
3. Onto one of the eyepins thread a cone flower bead cap, a white glass drop bead, and a pinwheel bead cap.
4. Make another simple loop and trim off excess wire.
5. Onto another eyepin thread the 20 mm round green glass bead, sandwiched between two 8 mm open flower bead caps.
6. Make another simple loop and trim off excess wire.
7. On the third eyepin thread a scalloped flower bead cap, a large 28 mm round glass bead, and a pinwheel bead cap.
8. Make another simple loop and trim off excess wire.
9. Onto the headpin thread a cone flower bead cap and a Swarovski bicone.
10. Make another simple loop and trim off excess wire.
11. Open the loop at the bottom of the drop bead and thread it through one of the loop on the smaller round bead. Close loop once more.
12. Open the loop on the opposite side of the smaller round bead and thread it though the loop on the large round bead closest to the scalloped bead cap. Close loop again.
13. Open the loop on the Swarovski bicone drop and thread it through the other loop on the large round bead. Close loop again.
