#### Instructions

- 1. Please watch our video: How to Make Colorful Suncatchers with Wire Frames.
- 2. From what you learned in the video, string on the beads to each wire spoke in the following order: one 3mm topaz, one orange teardrop, one 3mm topaz, five 10mm aquamarine, and one 3mm topaz.
- 3. Take your round nose pliers and make a simple wire loop at the end of the spoke. If you would like you can use crimping pliers to secure the loop at the end.
- 4. Continue to add beads to the other spokes and finishing with a simple loop.
- 5. From the video, cut a length of illusion cord, 8 inches long. Thread it through one of the simple wire loops. Tie a double overhand knot.
- 6. All done!
