

## Much Ado Earrings in Down the Aisle

### What You'll Need

SWAROVSKI ELEMENTS Rhodium Plated Channel Crystal Chain Crystal 6.8mm - BY THE FT

### Recommended Tools:

[XTL-5511] Beadsmith Jeweller's Micro Pliers Chain Nose Flat Nose



### Instructions

1. Open the jump rings to separate four links of silver plated crystal channel chain, leaving a jump ring on each end.
2. Place a silver plated 1.5", 22 gauge head pin through an 11mm white teardrop faux pearl and create a wrapped wire loop after the bead.
3. Open the jump ring on one end of the chain and hang the pearl drop from it; close the ring.
4. Use a silver plated 4mm, 21 gauge jump ring to hang the other end of the chain from the loop on a silver plated ball post earring. Make sure you have the included jump ring on the chain and a second jump ring here so that the channel chain hangs properly.
5. Place a silver plated earring back onto the earring post.

6. Repeat steps 1 - 5 to create a second earring.
