What You'll Need

SWAROVSKI ELEMENTS Gold Plated Channel Crystal Chain Crystal 6.8mm BY THE FOOT

Swarovski Crystal, 5821 Pear Shaped Faux Pearl Beads 11mm, 4 Pieces, Rose Gold

22K Gold Plated Stud Earrings Ball Post & Ring 4mm (20)

22K Gold Plated Head Pins - 22 Gauge/1.5 Inches (50)

[XTL-5511] Beadsmith Jeweller's Micro Pliers Chain Nose Flat Nose, [XTL-5514] Beadsmith Jewelry Fine Round Nose Micro Pliers, [XTL-5600] Xuron Sharp Flush Cutter Pliers - Wire/Soft Flex

Instructions

By following the instructions below, you will make one earring. Repeat all instructions to make the second earring.

- 1. Open the jump rings to separate four links of gold plated crystal channel chain, leaving a jump ring on each end.
- 2. Place a gold plated 1.5", 22 gauge head pin through an 11mm rose gold teardrop faux pearl and create a wrapped wire loop after the bead.
- 3. Open the jump ring on one end of the chain and hang the pearl drop from it; close the ring.





4. Use a gold plated 4mm, 21 gauge jump ring to hang the other end of the chain from the loop on a gold plated ball post earring.	Make sure you have the
included jump ring on the chain and a second jump ring here so that the channel chain hangs properly.	

5. Place a gold plated earring back onto the earring post.
