Beadalon Tassel Cord, Cotton Strands 0.76mm Thick, 20 Meters, Metallic Gold on Red

Instructions

Before beginning this project please watch our videos: How to Use the Beadalon Tassel Maker Tool and How to Add a Cone to a Tassel. By following the instructions below, you will make one earring. Repeat all instructions to make the second earring.

- 1. From what you learned in the first video, make one long tassel. Tie only one end and do not remove it from the winding tool yet.
- 2. Follow the instructions in the second video to complete the tassel with the cone.
- 3. Open the loop of the earring finding, same as you would a jump ring, and attach it to the loop you created on top of the cone.
