#### Instructions

By following the instructions below you will make one earring. Repeat all instructions to make the second earring.

- 1. Take one head pin and string on one silver bead, one mood tear drop bead, and one silver bead. Make a wrapped wire loop. Set aside.
- 2. Take one eye pin, string on one silver bead, one mood round bead and one silver bead. Make a simple wire loop. Set aside.
- 3. Take one eye pin, string on one silver bead. Make a simple wire loop. Set aside.
- 4. To assemble the earring, you will open and close the wire loops, the same as you would a jump ring.







- 5. Attach the earring hook to the eye pin with the single silver bead.
- 6. Attach the single silver bead to the eye pin with the round mood bead.
- 7. Attach the head pin with the tear drop to the other side of round mood bead eye pin.
- 8. All done!
