Instructions

By following the instructions below you will make one earring. Repeat all instructions to make the second earring. You will also need a paper towel for this project.

1. Please watch our video: How to Use Vintaj Patinas and Glaze.

2. From what you learned in the video, take your paint brush and dab patina into the bezel around the fleur de lis. Quickly use a paper towel to dab the excess paint so the fleur de lis is unpainted and the color is just in the bezel. Let dry for a few minutes.

3. Open the loop of the earring hook, same as you would a jump ring, and attach the shield charm. Close the loop.

4. All done!
