Instructions

By following the instructions below you will make one earring. Repeat all instructions to make the second earring.

1. Cut off 6 inches of beading wire.
2. Carefully slip three tassels off of the cord and thread the beading wire through the loops of the tassels.
3. Gather the two ends of the wire and slip them up through the cone. Slip on one gemstone bead and one crimp tube.
4. Take both wires through the closed jump ring and back down thru the crimp tube. Crimp the crimp tube. Trim any excess wire. Add a crimp cover.
5. Open the loop of the earring finding, same as you would a jump ring, and attach it to the closed jump ring. Close the loop.
