## **Instructions**

By following the instructions below you will make one earring. Repeat all instructions to make the second earring.

- 1. Begin by stringing one turquoise bead on to one eye pin. Make a simple wire loop with the loop facing perpendicular to the eye pin.
- 2. Open one loop of the eye pin, same as you would a jump ring, and attach this loop to the top of the teardrop focal. Close the loop.
- 3. Open the second loop of the eye pin and attach it to the loop of the earring hook. Close the loop, and you're all done.
