What You'll Need

Painted Ceramic Bead - Holiday Gingerbread Cookie 12.5x14.5 (2)

SKU: BWC-3034

Project uses 2 pieces

Gold Plated Flat 6mm Glue On Earring Posts (10 Pairs)

SKU: FEA-1615

Project uses 2 pieces

22K Gold Plated Earring Backs (Earnuts) Med. (100)

SKU: FEA-1015

Project uses 2 pieces

E6000 Industrial Strength Glue Adhesive (0.18 fl oz)

SKU: XTL-1054

Project uses 1 tube





By following the instructions below, you will make one earring. Repeat all instructions to make the second earring. You will need need a scrap of wire or glue applicator for this project.

- 1. Using your scrap of wire, add a dab of E6000 to the flat side of your gold plated earring post.
- 2. Next, flip your ceramic Gingerbread bead over and gently place the earring post onto the center.
- 3. Let your earring completely and then place the earring backs onto the posts.
- 4. And that's it!
