Instructions

By following the instructions below you will make one earring. Repeat all instructions to make the second earring.

- 1. First, watch our video on how to use Crystal Clay.
- 2. Put on the gloves that come with your Crystal Clay. Pinch one chickpea-sized amount each of the white clay and the binder and mix together until blended.
- 3. Place the clay into one earring bezel and tap until smooth.
- 4. Place one starfish bead in the center of the clay and lightly press so it is captured by the clay.
- 5. Using the beeswax tip applicator that comes with the Crystal Clay, place the Metallic Crystal Sunshine Swarovski crystal chatons around one side of the starfish.
- 6. Place the Light Turquoise Swarovski crystal chatons around the other side.
- 7. Let the clay cure for 14 to 16 hours, then your earrings are ready to wear!
