## Instructions

By following the instructions below you will make one earring. Repeat all instructions to make the second earring.

1. Take 1 pink tassel off of the strand. Open and attach a jump ring through the loop of thread at the top of the tassel. Close the jump ring.
2. Take 1 gold eye pin and open the loop at the bottom the same way you would open a jump ring. Slide on the jump ring with the tassel from the previous step. Close the loop of the eye pin.
3. String 15 mm round gold bead onto the eye pin. Then string 1 orange pom pom through the center. String another 5 mm gold bead. Make a simple wire
loop, and cut off the extra wire with flush cutters.
4. Open 1 earring hook and slide on the wire loop from the previous step. Close the earring hook. Enjoy your earrings!
