

Victorian Afternoon Earrings




These sterling silver earrings feature an intricate sterling silver filigree bead simply hung from an elegant earring hook. This design illustrates how a stunning focal is sometimes all you need for a beautiful piece of jewelry.



What You'll Need

Sterling Silver Cast - Round Victorian Filigree Bead 13mm (1)





Sterling Silver French Wire Earring Hooks (10) SKU: FEA-2010 Project uses 2 pieces

Sterling Silver Head Pins 22 Gauge 1.5 Inch (10)

Specialized Tools

Xuron Sharp Flush Cutter Pliers - Wire/Soft Flex

Instructions:

By following the instructions below, you will make one earring. Repeat all instructions to make the second earring.

- 1. Place one of your filigree beads onto a head pin. Create a wrapped wire loop after the bead and snip off excess wire with flush cutters.
- 2. Open the loop at the base of your earring hook (the same way you would open a jump ring) and link this to the wrapped wire loop

you just made. Close the loop.

3. All done! Enjoy!

Variations

Create this same design but choose a different sterling silver focal bead.

When substituting in items, pay attention to sizes and styles to make sure all your pieces will fit together.
