Instructions

By following the instructions below, you will make one earring. Repeat all instructions to make the second earring.

- 1. If you are not familiar with how to use wire looping pliers, please watch the video here.
- 2. Place onto a head pin 1 scalloped bead cap facing downwards. Measure 1/4" from the end of the head pin. At the 1/4" point, create a simple wire loop. Snip off excess wire with flush cutters. Repeat this step to create your second "leg" for your angel.
- 3. Take an eye pin and open the loop (the same way you would open a jump ring) and slip onto it the two dangles (legs) you made in the step above. Close the eye pin loop.
- 4. Place onto the eye pin: 1 SWAROVSKI ELEMENTS dome bead facing downwards, 1 angel wings bead, 1 SWAROVSKI ELEMENTS round bead, and 1 filigree bead cap facing upwards. Create a simple wire loop after the bead cap. Trim excess wire with flush cutters.
- 5. Open the loop at the base of your earring hook (the same way you would open a jump ring) and link this onto the simple wire loop you just made. Close the loop back up.
