

Christmas Wrappings Tree Earrings

These earrings are wonderfully festive yet elegant at the same time. A cultured sea glass triangle has been wire wrapped to become a fun and modern Christmas tree.

What You'll Need

22K Gold Plated Head Pins - 22 Gauge/1.5 Inches (50)

Cultured Sea Glass, Triangle Pendants 37x15mm - Opaque Spring Green (2 Pieces)

Instructions

By following the instructions below, you will make one earring. Repeat all instructions to make the second earring.

- 1. To wire wrap your cultured sea glass triangle, please watch the video: How to Make a Wire Wrapped Christmas Tree with Sea Glass Triangles.
- 2. Following what you learned in the video, wire wrap your cultured sea glass triangle in the style shown with the gold wire.
- 3. Place a gold filigree bead onto a head pin. Create a simple wire loop after the bead and cut off excess wire with flush cutters.
- 4. Open the simple wire loop that you just made and connect it to the wire loop at the base of your "tree". Close the loop.
- 5. Open the loop at the base of your earring hook (the same way you would open a jump ring) and connect this to the top loop on your "tree".
