Instructions

By following the instructions below, you will make one earring. Repeat all instructions to make the second earring.

1. Please watch the video: How to Make a Fringe Earring with Centerline Chandelier Pendants. In this video, you will see from start to finish how to create this design using Miyuki Delica 11/0 seed beads, Czech glass dagger beads, and slim rolo chain. These components will alternately hang from a 15-hole Centerline chandelier pendant. First, you will see how to add beads to the grooves in the Centerline pendant. Next, you will learn how to string and attach the beaded strands. Then you will see how to attach the chain lengths with dagger beads using jump rings. Lastly, you will see how to attach the earring hook.
