## Instructions

By following the instructions below, you will make one earring. Repeat all instructions to make the second earring.

1. Please watch the video: How to Make a Pair of Wire Wrapped Tiered Hoop Earrings. In this video, you will learn from start to finish how to create this design using 22 gauge craft wire with the BeadSmith 6-Piece Wooden Mandrel Set. First you will see how to cut and form the wire into hoops using mandrels ranging from $3 / 8$ to $7 / 8$ inch in diameter. Next, you will see how to connect the tiered hoops using simple wire loops. You will also see how to
attach an earring hook using an 8 mm jump ring. Finally, you will see how to add beads to the design using head pins and wrapped wire loops.
