#### **Recommended Tools:**

[XTL-101] Micro Grip Pliers, Long Chain Nose, 5 Inches Long, 1 Piece, [XTL-9920] Beadaholique Bead Mat, 12.5x9.25 Inches, 1 Piece





#### Instructions

By following the instructions below, you will make one earring. Repeat all instructions to make the second earring.

- 1. Slide one rectangle focal onto a beading hoop.
- 2. Use the tip of your chain nose pliers to grip the solid end of your hoop. Bend approximately 1/8 inch of the wire outward from the center of the hoop.
- 3. Enjoy your earrings!
