

## At a Gallop Necklace

A pretty pony pendant hangs from a green waxed cotton cord, with a black finish pewter heart charm below in this sweet little necklace.



### What You'll Need

Green Girl Studios Pewter Jumping Pony Focal Bead 28mm (1) - GG1  
SKU: BMB-9151  
Project uses 1 piece



Black Finish Lead-Free Pewter Scroll Puff Heart Beads 10mm (2)  
SKU: BMB-5628  
Project uses 1 piece



Waxed Cotton Cord 1mm Round - Bottle Green (5 Meters/16.5 Feet)  
SKU: XCR-4316  
Project uses 3 feet



Gun Metal Plated Head Pins 1.5 Inches/21 Gauge (50)  
SKU: FHP-6318  
Project uses 1 piece



E6000 Industrial Strength Glue Adhesive (0.18 fl oz)  
SKU: XTL-1054  
Project uses 1 tube



### Specialized Tools

Fiskars 5 Precision Tip Scissors - Super Sharp  
SKU: XTL-5700



### Instructions:

1. Place a black finish pewter scroll heart bead onto a 1.5", 21 gauge gun metal head pin and create a simple wire loop.
2. Cut a 2' length of bottle green 1mm waxed cotton cord. String the heart charm onto the center of the cord, then thread both ends back up through the bottom of a Green Girl Studios jumping pony focal bead. Pull the cord almost all the way up, leaving just a bit below the pony where the heart is hanging.
3. Make an overhand knot about 1/2" from each end of the cord. Cut another piece of cord 1' long. Use the new piece of cord to create a sliding knot clasp as demonstrated in this video. Place a dab of E6000 glue into the final knot as shown, and trim the ends of the knotted cord after the glue has dried.

### Variations

Choose your favorite Green Girl Studios animal bead, and a pretty charm to match, to create a different necklace.

When substituting in items, pay attention to sizes and styles to make sure all your pieces will fit together.
