Cultured Sea Glass Flat Freeform Beads 18-28mm - Cobalt Blue (5 Piece Strand)

Sterling Silver Fine Snake Chain 18 In. x .9mm Necklace

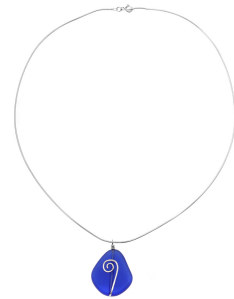

[XTL-5600] Xuron Sharp Flush Cutter Pliers - Wire/Soft Flex, [XTL-5511] Beadsmith Jeweller's Micro Pliers Chain Nose Flat Nose, [XTL-5514] Beadsmith Jewelry Fine Round Nose Micro Pliers, [XTL-5032] Beadsmith Wire Looping Pliers - Concave And Round Nose, [XTL-0248] Eurotool Brass Mallet For Metal Smithing - 1 Pound, [XTL-6092] Beadsmith Solid Steel Bench Block - Wire Hardening and Wire Wrapping Tool, [XTL-0254] Rubber Bench Block 4 x 4 Inches - Base for Steel Block



## Instructions

These materials will make 5 pendants, you'll just need to get additional necklaces to hang them from.

1. Watch the instructional video: How to Make a Spiral Wire Wrapped Sea Glass Pendant.
2. Follow the step by step instructions in the video to create your pendant. When you create your wrapped wire loop at the top, make sure you make your loop large enough to fit the smaller end of your necklace clasp.
3. Run the smaller end of your necklace clasp through your loop to hang the pendant from your chain.
