What You'll Need

Sterling Silver Spring Ring Round Clasps Closed Ring 5mm (10)

Sterling Silver Open Jump Rings 4mm 21 Gauge (20)

E6000 Industrial Strength Glue Adhesive (0.18 fl oz)

Antiqued Silver Plated Filigree Stamping - Ornate Square Flower 46mm (1)

Instructions:

- 1. Cut two lengths of chain at 7 3/4" long.
- 2. Add a jump ring to either end of both lengths of chain.
- 3. Add one end of piece of chain to two of the holes on either side of a point on the filigree stamping.
- 4. To the opposite end of one of the lengths of chain add a spring ring clasp.
- 5. Using a toothpick, dab a small amount of E6000 glue on to the backs of the rhinestones and position them in the center of the filigree stamping in this way: place one rhinestone in the very middle and the remaining rhinestones surrounding the center one. The glue will set in about six minutes, and full curing occurs within twenty-four hours.
