What You'll Need

Czech Glass Snake Beads, Round Firepolish 10mm, 1 Strand of 15 Pieces, Wind Mix

Silver Plated Open Eye Pins 21 Gauge 1.5 Inch (x50)

Silver Plated Long Flat Link Cable Chain 3.2x8.2mm - Bulk By The Foot

Instructions

1. Take one headpin, thread on one snake bead. Make a simple wire loop. Set aside. Repeat this 14 more times.
2. Now you will make a chain of snake beads by opening the wire loops the same way you would a jump ring and linking them together. You may follow my pattern of colors by referring to the photo or you can change it up.
3. To one end of the chain you just created, attach the silver chain by opening the wire loop the same way you would a jump ring and linking them together. Repeat on the other side to complete the necklace.
4. All done.
