What You'll Need

SWAROVSKI ELEMENTS Rhodium Plated Channel Crystal Chain Crystal 6.8mm - BY THE FT

SKU: CHA-2010

Project uses 1 Foot

Bright Silver Plated Round Rolo Chain 3mm Bulk By The Foot

SKU: CHA-9970

Project uses 42 Inches

Silver Plated Open Jump Rings 4mm 20 Gauge (50)

SKU: FJR-3911

Project uses 42 pieces

[XTL-5511] Beadsmith Jeweller's Micro Pliers Chain Nose Flat Nose, [XTL-5514] Beadsmith Jewelry Fine Round Nose Micro Pliers, [XTL-5600] Xuron Sharp Flush Cutter Pliers -

Wire/Soft Flex



Instructions

This finished necklace measures 56 inches.

- 1. Begin by separating the channel chain. Open the jump rings and remove them from the links. You will not be using these jump rings for this project.
- 2. Using your flush cutters cut off two inches of silver chain. To one end attach one channel link using one jump ring.
- 3. Cut off two more inches of chain. Attach this chain to the other side of the channel link you just added using one jump ring.
- 4. You will continue in this manner until you have added 21 channel charms.
- 5. When you come to the final link, attach it to the beginning of the chain to complete the necklace.
- 6. All done!
