Instructions

This necklace measures 22 inches in length. To modify the length, adjust the length of leather cord used.



- 1. Cut off 21 inches of leather cord.
- 2. Slide on the bee focal.
- 3. To one end of the leather add a fold over crimp cord end with your fold over crimping pliers. Move to the other side and repeat.
- 4. Open one jump ring and attach it to one cord end. Close the jump ring.
- 5. Open another jump ring and attach it to the other end and add on one lobster clasp. Close the jump ring.
