


## **Kilauea Necklace**

Kat Silvia Earth toned lava beads are paired with pewter metal beads and bead caps to achieve a colorful global chic look.



## **Recommended Tools:**



[XTL-3000] Bead Stopper- Stop Beads Sliding Off Stringing Material, [XTL-5608] Xuron 4 In 1 Crimping Pliers - Works On 1, 2 And 3mm Crimps!, [XTL-5600] Xuron Sharp Flush Cutter Pliers - Wire/Soft Flex, [XTL-5511] Beadsmith Jeweller's Micro Pliers Chain Nose Flat Nose

## Instructions

These instructions will give you a necklace that is 20" in length. To adjust the length, simply modify the number of beads strung respectively. Note: If you want a longer necklace you will need to purchase additional beads.

1. Cut off 24 inches of beading wire. Place a bead stopper 2 inches from one end.

2. String on your beads in this order: 24 spacer beads, 1 cube, 1 large round pewter bead, 1 cone (large side first), 1 large round pewter bead, 1 cube, 1 lava bead, 1 cube, 1 l

3. String on one crimp tube, followed by one thread protector. String the wire over the protector and down through the hole on the other side and down through the crimp tube. Pull snug and crimp tube. Trim the excess wire.

4. Move to the other side of the necklace, remove the bead stopper and then repeat the above step to add the crime tube and thread protector.

5. Finally, open a jump ring and attach one thread protector to one end of the toggle clasp and close the jump ring. Move to the other side of the necklace and attach the other side of the toggle clasp with another jump ring in the same manner.
